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Minutes of the Induction Programme:-

Sri Prosenjit Bhattacharya, Dy. Director, RC in his address welcomed learners described them the important and useful aspects of of university web portal (www.wbnsou.ac.in), for getting all the relevant information. Explained them the do's and don't's during the student life span in NSOU. Shri Arijit Ghosh, Assistant Prof. JMC demonstrated detailed procedure of Mobile App step by step. He highlighted the ICT services which are provided to the enrolled students through LMS and mobile app. described the UG-CBCS structure and distribution of CC, GE, AECC, SEC, DSE over the six semesters in detail and the examination pattern.
