The NSOU team had a details discussion with the TIC Dr. Susmita Pandit, coordinator Mr. Sudip Bhattacharya and other Officials of the LSC in his chamber and the following points were to be addressed:

- > The coordinator informed that the LSC was one of the oldest LSC of NSOU
- ➤ He also informed at present they are already qualified for the NAAC with 'B+' grade
- > The Coordinator informed us that they have sufficient classrooms concerning the number of learners.
- ➤ The Notice Board of the LSC is placed identically to update the circular of information among both learners and the official members.
- > The NSOU website is linked to the college website.

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The team from NSOU RC Jalpaiguri scheduled an Induction Meeting for the newly admitted learners at 11:30 p.m. on 07.04.24.

Shri Soumitra Sengupta, Superintendent of NSOU RC Jalpaiguri, Welcome all the learners and provide a quick introduction to the functions that are available at NSOU RC Jalpaiguri.

Shri Santanu Dam, Dy. Director NSOU RC Jalpaiguri explains the summary of the ODL System and emphasizes the significance of NSOU to the ODL Model. During a pandemic, he also discusses the significance of the ability of NSOU to expand its facilities to include other learning centers that are empowered with information and communication technology. Also, the importance of the learning management system (LMS) platform that NSOU makes available to its students. He provided a comprehensive overview of the various levels of programs that NSOU provides, categorized all of the essential information concerning the pre- and post-admission obligations and responsibilities of the learners, and explained how the learners can make use of the facilities and accessibility that NSOU provides to them through the P.P.P. technique. He made his entire excellencies available to the audience in order to accomplish the goals of increasing awareness and giving them a sense of self-empowerment. In addition, the necessity of NAAC accreditation was emphasized throughout the presentation. He also informed that NSOU is presently accredited by NAAC with 'A' grade.

Shri Debraj Sarkar provide a concise explanation and demonstration of how to use the information and communication technology (ICT) capabilities that are made available to the learners by NSOU. Additionally, he goes over all of the technical aspects of the NSOU App and demonstrates how to utilize it in front of the learners.

Dr. Ushnish Sarkar, Assistant Professor of Mathematics primarily discuss regarding academic and counselling-related topics. What strategies may they employ to deal with this circumstance, given that they are students of the ODL system, which is very different from the conventional system. The ODL system and normal system learning methods are very different from one another. During his speech, he discussed the potential benefits and adaptability of the Open System. How can they improve and increase their learning process through the counselling process. Most importantly, how can students learn the importance of studying SLMs, PCPs, SLPs, and counselling sessions that the university provides for them in blended mode. The techniques of creating assignments and constructing the syllabus, among other things, demanded that students check the university website regularly, make modifications to themselves through the use of the internet, and provide the NSOU with their important feedback.

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A detailed discussion about the benefit of Academic Bank of Credit

The definition of a bank of credit is succinctly given by Shri Santanu Dam, Dy. Director of NSOU. The Academic Bank of Credits (ABC) has been designed, by National Education Policy 2020, to support students' academic mobility by granting them the freedom to study at any Higher Education Institution in the nation and providing a suitable "credit transfer" mechanism from one programme to another, ultimately leading to the attainment of a Degree, Diploma, PG-diploma, etc.

Subsequently, Shri Debraj Sarkar addressed the procedure of creating ABC ID and addressed any questions regarding issues that the students encountered when creating an ABC ID.
