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**A brief Induction Program for newly admitted learners of NSOU in Coochbehar
College LSC**

The team from NSOU RC Jalpaiguri scheduled an Induction Meeting for the newly admitted learners at 1:30 p.m. on 07.01,23.

Shri Soumitra Sengupta, Superintendent of NSOU RC Jalpaiguri, Welcome all the learners and briefly introduced all the learners about the functionalities of NSOU RC Jalpaiguri.

Shri Santanu Dam, Dy. Director NSOU RC Jalpaiguri explains the ODL System also how crucial NSOU is to the ODL Model. Additionally, he explains how NSOU's ability to expand its facilities to other ICT-enabled learning centers plays a crucial role during a pandemic. Also the necessity of usage of LMS platform provided by NSOU for their learners. He provided a broad overview of the several levels of programs that NSOU offers, classifies all the crucial information regarding the pre- and post-admission obligations and responsibilities of the learners and how they can utilize the facilities and accessibility that NSOU offers to the learners via the P.P.P. technique. In order to raise awareness and provide the audiences with a sense of self-empowerment, he offered them his whole excellencies. Additionally, emphasis was placed on the significance of NAAC accreditation.

Shri Debraj Sarkar briefly explain and demonstrate how to use ICT facilities provided by NSOU for the learners. He also demonstrate all the technicalities of the NSOU App and how to use it in front of the learners.

Shri Anupam Roy, Assistant Professor of Sociology primarily discusses academic and counselling matters. As a learner of the ODL system that is extremely different from the regular system, how can they cope with this situation? Differences between the ODL system and regular system learning methods. He spoke about the advantages and flexibilities of the Open System. Through the counselling process, how can they improve and enhance their learning process and mostly the importance of learning SLMs, PCP, and counselling sessions that the university provides to them. The methods of writing assignments and preparing syllabus, etc., at least but not the last, requested to check the university website regularly and make updates own self through online and put their valuable feedback to the NSOU.

• **A detailed discussion about the benefit of Academic Bank of Credit**

The definition of a bank of credit is succinctly given by Shri Santanu Dam, Dy. Director of NSOU. The Academic Bank of Credits (ABC) has been designed, in accordance with National Education Policy 2020, to support students' academic mobility by granting them the freedom to study at any Higher Education Institution in the nation and providing a suitable "credit transfer" mechanism from one programme to another, ultimately leading to the attainment of a Degree, Diploma, PG-diploma, etc.

Subsequently, Shri Debraj Sarkar addressed the procedure of creating ABC ID and addressed any questions regarding issues that the students encountered when creating an ABC ID.

• **Cultural Program conducted by the Learners of NSOU**
