About NSOU

NSOU came under the ambit of Distance Education Council's recognition in April, 2008 vide its Memo No.F:DEC/ Recog/2008. As a centre of excellence in ODL (Open and Distance Learning) mode, NSOU was awarded the membership of AIU (Association of India Universities), New Delhi 110 002.

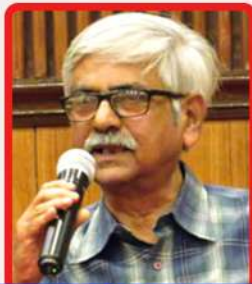
